CAHN Nursing Award: Distinguished Service Award

This award gives recognition to a CAHN nurse who has excelled in contributing to the hepatology nursing profession in a number of ways over a minimum span of membership of at least 5 years.

The CAHN Awards Committee will look for specific examples that indicate how the nominee has:

- demonstrated an ongoing commitment to enhancing the quality of life and health promotion to those living with liver disease.
- promoted good clinical practice through research and uses current findings in his/her practice
- utilized the Standards of Practice and Competencies in her/his practice
- educated health care providers working with clients with liver disease
- mentored other Hepatology nurses and members of the health care team to foster collaborative practice

The Awards Committee anticipates that this Distinguished Service Award may not be awarded annually and there may be more than one recipient on a given year. The recipient(s) may be retiring or transitioning from active Hepatology practice.
